Greenville District, State of South Carolina, Know all men by these  
presents that I David Croft of the said State and district for and in consideration  
of the sum of Seven hundred & Ninety Dollars to me in hand paid by William  
Dacus, have granted bargained sold conveyed and Released and by these Presents  
do grant bargain sell convey & Release unto the said William Dacus of the s<sup>d</sup> District  
and State, a Parcel of Land it being parts of three different original grants, the  
one granted unto Francis Bremer & Peter Jaenouan in 1786. for six hundred forty acres  
and another a part of an original grant granted unto David Vestal on the 3<sup>rd</sup>  
day of November 1788. also part of another original grant granted unto Valentine  
Harlin the 29<sup>th</sup> day of November 1792. Situate & laying on Peedy River in the State  
and district aforesaid, Beginning on a Crooked poplar on the Poplar branch, thence  
S. 60 W. 10.30 to a lightwood stump, thence N. 45. W. 27.50 to a lightwood stake, thence  
S. 50 W. 29. to a pine stake, thence at 40 W. 25. 28. to a Red oak corner, thence on S. line  
to a black oak on the original line, thence N. on the same to a pine N. 75 E. to a  
conditional line agreed on by W<sup>m</sup> Dollard & Jacob Croft, thence N. 68 E. 8. to a dogwood  
thence N. 25 W. 4.50 to a red oak stump, in the field thence N. 50 E. to a pine sapling  
at the Paged Shoal on Peedy River thence down the meanders of s<sup>d</sup> River to the mouth  
of the Poplar branch thence up the meanders of said branch to the Beginning —  
Containing four hundred and forty three acres of Land more or less including  
the plantation whereon David Croft formerly lived, and situate in the State & District  
aforesaid on the west side of Peedy River, Together with all and singular the Rights  
members hereditaments & appurtenances to the s<sup>d</sup> Premises belonging or in any  
wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the Premises  
before mentioned unto the said William Dacus his heirs and assigns forever and  
the said David Croft do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators  
to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said William  
Dacus his heirs and assigns forever against myself & my heirs and against every other Person  
whomsoever Lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part. Witness my hand & seal this 21<sup>st</sup> day  
of March one thousand eight hundred and eleven, & in the 35<sup>th</sup> year of American Independence. Signed sealed acknowledged
