South Carolina Greenville District, Know all men by these presents that we the undersigned (Legates of the Estate of Mrs. Clark Deceased) being of the State aforesaid and of Pendleton & Greenville Districts, for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty Dollars to each of us in hand paid by Arthur Clark of the State aforesaid & District of Greenville, have granted bargained sold and Released unto the above A. Clark all our part right & title to a certain piece or parcel of Land containing three hundred and four acres more or less lying and being in Greenville District waters of Saluda River being part of a tract of land originally granted to William Reid containing 691 acres dated the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of March 1792. Beginning on William Clarks line and on a Red oak Richard Ramsays corner, thence along the original line running N. 25<sup>th</sup> W. till it intersects with John Moors line, thence on the said line, untill it intersects with the original line N. 70<sup>th</sup> E. to a Post oak the original corner, thence on the original line S 53<sup>th</sup> to a stake Richard Ramsays corner, from thence on the S. Ramsays line to the Beginning Red oak corner containing three hundred and four acres unto the above
