State of South Carolina Greenville District, Know all men by these presents that Isaac Towers sen. of the state and district aforesaid, for and in consideration of Two hundred and fifty Dollars to me in hand paid by Hartwell Richards of the state and district aforesaid. Have granted bargained sold and Released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and Release unto the said Hartwell Richards all that tract or parcel of Land containing one one hundred and twelve acres be the same more or less, it being a part of a tract of Two hundred and fifty acres, originally granted to Josua Sanders by Patton bearing date the 21st day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Eighty five, situate in the state and district aforesaid, on the south side of Enoree River on both sides of Peters Creek waters of Enoree River, the land to be conveyed begins on a post oak & old marker for S. tract on the north side of Peters creek & runs N. 60 W. 25 Ch. on the original line to a stake new made thence through said tract S. 30 W. 14. 50 to a stake corner new thence S. 60 E. 6 Ch. to a poplar & new, thence on the dividing line between where said Towers now lives & where Samuel Lewis formerly lived to the branch, thence said branch to be the line down to a stake corner near a little shoal on S. branch thence straight across to an oak corner on the other fork of said branch, thence said branch to be the line to the head thereof, thence to a black oak near the head, thence to continue a straight line up the hollow to a stake corner new, on the original line thence on said line S. 60 E. 19 Ch. to a hickory & old thence on the old line N. 30 E. 50 Chains to the
