To have & to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John Mayfield his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs, executors & administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises, unto the said John Mayfield his heirs & assigns against myself my heirs & against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
