 thence N 25 E 72 6 to a Stake thence S 65 E 32 675 L to a Stake thence S 25 W  
 366 to a Stake thence S 65 E 66 6 to white Oak on the bank of the Branch  
 thence down the meanders of the branch to the Beginning it being part  
 of a tract of land originally granted to Peter Sweany containing six  
 hundred and forty acres granted by his Excellency William Moultrie  
 the sixth day of March 1786 it being on a branch of Cripel Creek  
 waters of Reedy River Greenville District together with all and singular  
 the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises  
 belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all  
 and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Samuel Morrow his  
 heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and
