



by his Excellency William Moultrie Esq. bearing date the 3^d of October 1785, and conveyed from said Mary Burns to Alexander Smith and from him to George Smith laying on cedar shoal Branch waters of Pedy River in the district aforesaid. Beginning on a red oak on the original line S³E. 20 chains to a branch thence down said branch S¹48E. 40 ch. to an oak on the old line thence N. 55 E. to a Red oak & thence N. about 10 degrees E. to a stake thence N. 60 W. to the Beginning, to include one hundred acres be the same more or less. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises therunto belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have & To hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Daniel Ford his heirs or Executors and assigns forever. And I George Smith do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and assigns to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Daniel Ford his heirs Executors and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this Eleventh day of September A. Eighteen hundred and Eleven, And in the 36th year of the American Independancy. Signed Sealed and Delivered in presence of us.
