South Carolina To all to whom these presents shall come William Bowen of Laurens District & Horatio Griffin of Greenville District in the state aforesaid, send Greeting, Whereas we the said William Bowen & Horatio Griffin by our bond or obligation bearing even date with these presents, we are held and firmly bound unto John & Charles Bulow in the penal sum of seventeen thousand Seven hundred and sixty two Dollars Ninety two cents with a condition thereunder written for the payment of the sum of Eight thousand Eight hundred and Eighty one Dollars forty six cents, unto the said John & Charles Bulow their heirs Executors administrators or assigns, as in and by the said Bond or obligations and condition thereunder written (relation whereunto being had) doth more fully and at large appear, NOW Know ye that we the said William Bowen & Horatio Griffin for the better securing the payment of the said sum of Eight thousand Eight hundred and Eighty one Dollars forty six cents unto the said John & Charles Bulow their heirs Executors administrators or assigns together with lawful interest for the same, have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell, in plain and open market deliver unto the said John & Charles Bulow, Ready about 25 years of age with her three children say Jerry Frank & Monday, Harry about 18 years old, Jude about 30 years of age with her mulattoe child Nanny, Abba about 18 years of age with her boy child Jacob, Menty about 18 years of age, big Sam 20 years of age, little Sam 18 years of age, big Jack 35 years of age, Dianna his wife 30 years of age, Mill 35 years of age, Phuby 35 years of age with her girl child Nancy, Carolina 20 years of age, and Flora 30 years of age, To have and to hold the said negroy Ready with her three children, Jerry Frank & Monday Harry Jude with her mulattoe
