State of S. Carolina Greenville District Know all men by these presents that I
William Kelly of the State of Tennessee for in consideration of the sum of Seven
hundred dollars forty dollars to me in hand paid by Micajah Berry of the said
state and district, I have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents
do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Micajah Berry a parcel of land
containing three hundred and twenty acres it being part & tract originally granted
to John Wren for six hundred and forty acres bearing date sixteenth day of July
1784 and recorded in grant book A. A. et al Page 57 laying on Reedy River in the
district aforesaid thence conveyed round to the said William Kelly Beginning on a white
gum on said River and running S. 74 W. 39 ch. to a white oak on a branch thence up
the meanders of said branch about 26 chains to a dead poplar thence on the original
line N. 77 chain 40 L. to a post oak thence E. 25 chain to a red oak on the River thence down
the meanders of said River to the Beginning to include three hundred and twenty acres
with the plantation where Bridget Kelly now lies together with all and singular the rights
members hereditaments and appurtenancy to the said premises belonging or in any
wise incident appertaining To have & to hold all and singular the premises before
mentioned unto the said Micajah Berry his heirs and assigns forever And I William
Kelly do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and
forever
