 old line thence along S^r line to the conditional line thence along S^r line to the
 Black gum Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments
 and appurtenances to the premises belonging to have and to hold all and
 singular the premises above mentioned unto the S^r John Cox his heirs and assigns
 I bind myself my heirs Executors or administrators to warrant and for ever
 defend all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the S^r John Cox
 his heirs or assigns against myself my heirs or assigns and every other person or

 part of the tract Beginning on a black on little horse creek the Water of ready course
 Running thence S^r 20. W 55 E. N. to a post oak thence N. 37. E. 15. 75. to a stake thence N. 0
 65. E. 8. to a stake thence N. 5. E. 18 to a white oak thence N. 3. E. 35. 50. down the meanders of
 a branch to little horse creek thence up the meanders of S^r Creek to the Beginning
 including the plantation whereon the S^r Mullican now lives together with one.
