I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises unto the said Thruston his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and against every other person or persons whatsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof, As witness our hands and seals this 30<sup>th</sup> day of Feb<sup>r</sup>y 1813.
