

Corner on the south side of Beaver dam Creek thence Westwardly to a Pine Corner  
 thence near the same course to Solomon Kemps Corner, thence along said Kemps  
 line Southwardly across Wolf Creek to a line surveyed for Elizabeth Young, thence  
 Eastwardly along said line across Wolf Creek to a red Oak Corner, thence Northwardly  
 to the beginning, including within these lines seventy five acres of land, more or less,  
 Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances  
 to the said Premises belonging or in any wise appertaining, To have and to hold all  
 and singular the said premises unto the said Benjamin Benson his heirs <sup>Executors</sup> and assigns for  
 ever or any of them, to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises  
 unto the said Benjamin Benson his heirs and assigns, and against myself and my heirs law-  
 fully claiming the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this 19<sup>th</sup> day of

This Indenture made the twenty fifth day of January eighteen hundred and  
 thirteen between Duncan Wilkerson of Greenville District of the one part, and Young  
 Griffen of the other part, Witnesseth that the same Duncan Wilkerson for the sum of  
 Six hundred dollars in hand paid by said Young Griffen the receipt whereof he doth acknow-  
 ledge, and by these Presents hath bargained sold and Granted, and doth by these Presents  
 deliver and confirm unto the said Young Griffen his heirs and assigns for ever, a certain  
 Tract or parcel of land situate and bounding as follows, on the South side of South Tigar River  
 beginning on a Sapsopas Corner on the bank of the river, thence on Douthenwhos land, thence on  
 Nichols land to a red oak Corner thence on Chastien's line to a marked Poplar, thence conti-  
 nuing the said line to the river where it intersects with Young P. Pool's line thence down the  
 meanders of the river to the beginning, all together containing three hundred and seventy  
 acres be the same more or less, with all houses fences orchards woods underwood water water  
 courses thereunto belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining thereto, To have & to hold  
 the said tract or parcel of land and all the before mentioned premises unto the said Young Griffen  
 and his heirs forever, to warrant the said tract of land and premises unto the said Young Griffen his heirs and  
 assigns forever. In Witness whereof the s<sup>d</sup> Duncan Wilkerson hath set his hand & affixed his seal the day
