

in to me In hand paid by John Whit of the State & District aforesaid have Granted bargain  
Sold & released and by these presents do Grant bargain sell & release unto the said John  
Whit a plantation and parcel of Land containing Forty one acres situated in the State &  
District aforesaid on the Golden Bear Creek waters of Saluda River. It being part of two  
original Grants one Granted to Richard Ford, and the other Granted to William Cobb Begin  
ning on a stake (on the S. W. Bank of the Score Creek) Thence N. W. 85° E. to a stake Thence S. 7°  
55' 7.50 to a stake Thence N. W. 57° 12' 50 to a post oak Sap by oak Max wells old line N. E. 20° 18' (along  
S. E. old line) to a stake (on Boyds line) Thence S. E. 70° 11' 50 to a Spanish oak near the Bank  
of S. E. Score Creek Thence down the meander of the S. E. Creek to the Beginning. Together with all &  
Singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging  
or in any wise Incident or appertaining: To have and to hold, all and singular, the premises  
before mentioned unto the said John Whit, his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind  
myself my heirs Executors administrators to wear out and forever defend all and  
Singular the s<sup>d</sup> premises unto the s<sup>d</sup> John Whit his heirs and assigns against my-  
self and my heirs and against every person whomsoever Lawfully Claiming or to Claim  
in the same or any part thereof, as witness my hand and seal this fifteenth Day of Oct-  
ober Eighteen hundred and twelve, and in the Thirty sixth year of the American
