

I William Waites of the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid in consider-
ation of the sum of Thirty Dollars to me paid by Thomas Long sen^r of the coun-
ty and State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by
these presents do Grant bargain sell & release unto the said Thomas Long sen^r
Twenty acres of Land more or less lying on the south side of Reedy River in Greenville
County being part of a tract of Land originally Granted to Lewis Durall and signed
by his excellency William Moultrie on the Thirty First day of May one Thousand
seven Hundred and Eighty Six, the said Twenty acres more or less is Laid out unto

the said Thomas Long as follows. Beginning on black oak on the south bank
of said Reedy River below the cherries shoal thence running westward to a
black oak corner on the line of the above mentioned Tract of Land thence running N.
25. E. to a pine corner thence N. 65. E. to a willow oak corner on the bank of the said
Reedy River from thence running down & bounding on the said Reedy River to the begin-
ning Including Twenty Acres of Land more or less, Together with all & singular
