

Articles of agreement drawn this ^{20th} day of April in the Year of 1814
 our Lord one thousand Eight Hundred and fourteen, Between Polley
 Thomas of the District of Greenville and State of S^c. Carolina of the one part
 and William D. Thomas Culbertson of said ^{District} State aforesaid. The parties do
 mutually agree & bind themselves their heirs &c. to stand to, and abide by this
 agreement in the division of the Estate of William Davis Thomas Deceased
 in manner following to wit. Polley Thomas widow of William D Thomas
 deceased is to have all that part or parcel of Land commonly called the home
 tract that lies on the N^o. Side of Sa Tyger River to her & her heirs forever
 Also one Negro man Sam & one Negro girl. Annes also to her & her heirs forever
 also household and kitchen furniture, also stock of all kinds for the said
 Polley Thomas is to have hold & enjoy during her life & at her death for her to
 dispose as she may see cause, which property as above named is to be as her
 right of Dower. Also she is to have the plantation utensils and what few working
 tools on the place, the balance of the whole Estate real & personal consisting of
 Negroes Lands &c to the only use and benefit of the said W^m. D. Culbertson to him
 his heirs Executors &c to be at his disposal as his right and property for his only
 use and behoof. The said Polley Thomas & W^m. D. J. Culbertson do agree and
 bind themselves their heirs &c. as above. In witness whereof the parties have
 set their hands and seals day & date as above signed seal^d & delivered in pre

 D Thomas deceased by by her mark and W^m. D. J. Culbertson sign seal and
 acknowledge the within agreement for the uses and purposes therein mentioned
 and that Margaret J. Reynolds & Allen Marshall were subscribing witnesses
 to the same sworn to & subscribed before me this 20th April 1814

South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I John Davis
 of the State aforesaid and Greenville District for & in consideration of the sum
 of Three Hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Alexander M^r Makin of
 the State aforesaid & Spartanburg District have granted bargained sold and released
 and by these presents do Grant bargain sell and release unto the said Alexander
 M^r Makin Two plantations or tracts of Land adjoining each other one granted
 to Michael Walling containing one Hundred and Twenty two acres be the same
 more or less and the other containing one Hundred and Twelve acres
