

unto belonging or in any wise appertaining. To have and to hold all & singular
the premises before mentioned unto the said Alexander M^o Makin his heirs and
assigns forever & I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & administrators to
warrant & defend forever, the said premises all but Ten acres excepted in the
fork of the branch where Robt. Connell now lives the branch next Davis
land to be the line unto the said Alex^o M^o Makin his heirs & assigns against
myself & my heirs and against every other person or persons lawfully claiming or
to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this Eighteenth
day of December one Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirteen and in the thirty
seventh Year of the sovereignty of the united States of America signed seal^d and
delivered in presence of

consideration of the sum of Fifty Dollars to me in hand paid by Alex-
ander M^o Makin of the same place have Granted bargained sold and
released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto
the said Alexander M^o Makin a tract or parcel of Land containing
Forty acres be the same more or less, Bounded as follows beginning at a
white oak on the S^o side of Beaverdam Creek, thence along Montgomery
line to a chestnut thence to Watsons line and back to John Davis's line
Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and
appurtenances to said premises belonging or in any wise incident or ap-
pertaining. To have & to hold all & singular the premises before
mentioned unto the said Alexander M^o Makin his heirs
