the waters of Reedy River near the South Side of Parrott Mountain
and a part of the Tract of Land that formerly belonged to John
Langston deceased and Bounded as follows (viz) Beginning on a Black
Gum S. 68. E. 21. 14 to a stake, thence S 23 W. 15. 78. to a post oak. Thence
S 79 W. 13. 00 to a sweet Gum. Thence N. 27. W. 5. 50. to a sweet Gum on
the off Branch. thence up the said Branch with the meanders of the
same to the beginning — Together with all & singular the rights in-
hereditaments & appurtenances to said Land & premises, to have
and to hold all & singular to the said Land & premises before mentioned
unto the said Andrew Bridges his heirs & assigns forever —
And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors & administrators to
warrant & forever defend all & singular the said Land & premises
before mentioned to the said Andrew Bridges his heirs & assigns forever
against myself my heirs or any other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim
