South Carolina Greenville Know all men by these presents that I Arthur Clark of the state and District aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by John Corr of said state and District have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said John Corr all that parcel or tract of land containing one hundred acres more or less situate on the north side of Saluda river in the State and District aforesaid beginning at a red oak ^{oak} on the bank of said river running N 70 E with my own line 7 ch to a red oak x thence S 59 E still with said line 5 ch 75 L to a Post oak x 3, thence N 70 E along said line 48 ch to a Post oak x 3 thence N 59 W 5 ch 75 L to a Stone x 3 where it intersects W. Bowns line, thence S 70 W with said Bowns line 24 ch to a red oak x 3. thence N 15 W with said line 31 ch 20 L to a Post oak x 3 thence S 70 W still with said Bowns line 25 ch 50 L to a red oak x 3 on the bank of said river, thence down the meanders of said river to the beginning. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appertanances thereunto belonging or in anywise incident, to have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said John Corr his heirs and assigns for ever.
