Know all men by these presents that I Solomon Murphy for in consideration of the sum of fifty eight Dollars to me in hand paid by Isaiah Hide of the District & State aforesaid, have granted, bargained and sold unto the S^r Isaiah Hide all that tract or parcel of land containing four hundred acres more or less, beginning on Henry Masher's line running to Lafferty's line to a black jack corner, from thence on a dividing line to a large pine on the west side of Chandlers branch, from thence a long the dividing to Masher line. Together with all and singular the rights members and appertinances to have and to hold unto the S^r Isaiah Hide his heirs and assigns forever. I bind myself my heirs and Executors &c. from ever claiming the same

Know all men by these presents that I Miles Jennings heir to the estate of Myles Jennings deceased of the district of Greenville in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred Dollars to me paid by William Tate of Pendleton District in the State aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold and released, & by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said William Tate his heirs and assigns forever all that tract of land containing in the whole one thousand eight hundred & twenty three acres more or less, situate on the waters of Saluda River, both side thereof, bounding (at the time of the survey thereof in the year 1786) on lands of Richard Brown & near the lands of Drury Morris, Simon Ellis, M. M. Veis & vacant land in the then District of Ninety six. Also all that other plantation or tract of land containing one thousand six hundred & sixty four acres, situate in the District aforesaid, on the waters of Rudy River & Rayburns Creek bounded on lands of General Huger, Nathan Kemp, Cap^t. Wood, Cap^t. Choise, M^r. Reid, M^r. Chewit, & on old surveys, and also all that other plantation or tract of land containing one thousand six hundred & thirty acres more or less, situate in the aforesaid District of ninety six, on both sides of middle Creek (a branch of Rayburns creek)
