

Originally granted to James Winn on Martins Creek, to include one hundred and fifty acres be the same more or less, together with all the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in any wise incident appertaining, to have and to hold all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said John Stannis, his heirs and assigns forever. And I Thomas Hopkins do hereby bind myself, and my heirs, Executors, Administrators, and assigns, against myself and my heirs and against every other Person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. As witness my hand and seal this third day of March Eighteen hundred and fourteen and in 38 and 39 year of the American Independence
