


 Hulitt Sullivan his heirs & assigns forever. And we do hereby bind ourselves to
 warrant (and our heirs) and defend all and singular the said premises unto the
 said Hulitt Sullivan his heirs and assigns, against ourselves our heirs & every
 other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any

 down to said Southerlan, the land to be conveyed beginning on a Stake running
 S 50 W. 42.90 to a red oak 3+ Thence S 42 E 50 to 2 pines 3+ each. then due N. 6
 the beginning by Susannah Summerlans line including one hundred acres; Together
 with all and singular the rights, members, and appurtenances, to the said
 premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining; to have & to hold
 all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William Owens,
 their life time, and at their death to their son Alfred Owens, and I do hereby
 bind myself, my heirs, executors administrators and assigns, to warrant and
 defend all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the s. W. Owens, Miles
 Owens & Alfred Owens aforesaid their heirs and assigns forever, against myself
