Banour line, on the West side Jacob Nabors line, on the N^o by Hager line, on the
East by Harris Mullens line, being part of a tract of land granted to W^m Story
and conveyed to James Chastain, and also conveyed from s^r Chastain to s^r
Mullens, reference being thereunto had may more fully appear, and also all
the land, trees, timber trees, woods, under woods, bythes, Common of pastures
ways, water, water courses, and appurtenances what so ever to the same belonging
or in any wise appertaining, and also the reversion and reversion, remainder &
remainders, rights, uses, and services, of the said premises, and every part &
part thereof; and all the estate rights and titles, interests, claims, & demands
whatsoever of him the s^r Harris Mullens of in and to the said premises & every
part thereof; To have and to hold the said tract of fifty acres of land, more
or less, and all and singular the premises above mentioned and every
