Know all men by these presents that I John Barrett of the State and District aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of four dollars to me in hand paid by John Dill of the District aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto John Dill a tract of supposed to be five acres more or less, joining lands belonging to Runnel Dill the North side of Parks Mountain on the Waters of Parks Creek it being part of a tract of land granted to said John Barrett containing one hundred and seventy acres, Beginning on a Post Oak corner on Runnel Dills land, thence along "the foot of" Parks mountain near an East Course to a Spanish Oak, thence to a Sour wood corner above the Spring thence down the Spring branch till it intersects with the said Runnel Dills line together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said land and premises belonging or in any wise appertaining thereunto; To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John Dill his heirs and assigns; and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said John Dill his heirs and assigns against myself and all other persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fourteen September 21st.
