South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I Carter Tarrant of the district of Greenville and state aforesaid and in consideration of one hundred and seventy dollars to me paid by John Townes of the district and state aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said John Townes a tract or parcel of land lying and being in the district of Greenville and state aforesaid lying on the Grove creek bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a crab-apple tree and runs South East to the grove on Josiah Thompsons line thence up the Creek to a red oak on Millie Bensons line thence South West on said Bensons line to a white oak thence South to the beginning corner containing fifty acres of land more or less being part of a tract of Land which Jeremiah Smith Senr. formerly lived on Together with all and singular the Rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To Have & To Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John Townes his heirs Executors & administrators forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and defend forever all and singular the said premises unto the said John Townes his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully Claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
