The State of South Carolina, Know all men by these presents that I Vincent Harrison of Greenville District and State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred dollars to me in hand paid by William Toney of the district and State aforesaid, Have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said William Toney all those several tracts or parcels of Land herein after described to wit, one tract containing sixty five acres more or less, beginning on a Red oak on the bank of the River thence a conditional line to a Red oak near an old house thence to a peace tree a conditional line thence to a red oak thence to a red oak on Fountains line thence on S. line to a hickory thence to a red oak corner, thence a conditional line to a Post oak thence to a red oak, thence to a black gum on the river thence the river the line to the Beginning, it being originally granted to Paul Fountain bearing date the 4th day of July 1780. and Conveyed to Robert Cannon from said Cannon to Robert Harrison from R. Harrison to me; also one other tract or parcel of Land adjoining the above contain- ing Ninety seven acres more or less lying in the district aforesaid, beginning on Fountains old line on a black oak E. 21:35 to a red oak thence S. 44:72 to a post-oak, thence N. 21:35 to a post-oak thence S. a conditional line to a Large Hickory thence to a white oak thence to a Hickory and thence a conditional line to the beginning, with the exception of two springs used by Reubin Harrison also the three acre tract conveyed from Joseph Williams to me is intended to be included in the last mentioned land, Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the said premises, belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining, To Have & To Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William Toney his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs, Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend
