The State of South Carolina, Know all men by these presents that I Joseph Williams  
 of Greenville District and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of five  
 hundred & 20 cts to me paid by William Toney of the district and State aforesaid  
 Have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant  
 bargain sell and release unto the said William Toney all those several  
 tracts or parcels of Land herein after mentioned described to wit one tract  
 containing four hundred acres more or less lying and being in Greenville district  
 on Branches of Saluda River Beginning on a Stake Agers line thence West to a  
 Hickory Vincent Harrison's corner thence his line to a stake corner Tho. Richardson  
 thence his line N. 39 E. 81 chains to a post oak thence said Richardson's line to a pine  
 thence S. 70 E. 17 Ch<sup>rs</sup> to a pine thence N. 35 E. 21 chains to a stake, thence S. 71  
 E. 5 chains to a pine John Thornton's corner thence his line South 11 chains 20 lks  
 to a Red oak thence John Robinson's line to a red oak thence S. 25 N. 16 chains to a  
 Post oak thence to the Beginning, also one other tract or parcel of Land adjoining  
 the above containing two hundred acres more or less originally granted to  
 Daniel Langford the 2<sup>d</sup> day of October 1786. situate lying and being in the  
 district aforesaid beginning on Saluda River on a black gum running E. 44. 72 to  
 a Red oak thence S. 55. 72 to a post oak & thence N. 44. 72 to a stake & thence up  
 the meander of said River to the beginning, also one other tract or parcel of Land
