Bridwell of the other part Witnesseth that the said Burgess Smith doth
bargain and sell a tract of land lying and being in Greenville District
Catawba River Containing one hundred acres be it more or less unto the said
J. Bridwell, it being a tract of land of A. Benson & A. Barney a survey,
Beginning on a black jack corner, from thence along old Curry N. to red
oak corner from thence along said line W. to a Spanish oak corner
from thence to enoche in the line to said Hollars spring branch from thence
bounded on Barney line to a black jack on the beginning corner, so as
to conclude all woods water, or any thing appertaining thereto the said
B. Smith from his heirs, Ex^{ors} adm^{rs} or assigns doth warrant and defend
from any other person or persons forever claiming or touching said land
tract of land unto the said J. Bridwell his heirs, Ex^{ors} adm^{rs} or assigns
forever warranting and defending bearing date on the year of our
Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifteen - it being the second

my son Edward Stuart Junr. as follows Considering myself not of ability
to labor as I formerly have done I give unto him the said Edward
all the land and the elements I now am in possession of together with
farming utensils, and all tools that I have my stock of Hogs one
white Cow and calf and every species of property I own in the State
aforesaid (except one feather bed & furniture for Mahala and her boy)
