The said Crenshaw to have the Equity of redemption that is the day by paying and discharging the said sum of one hundred and seventy seven dollar and fifty cents on or by the twenty third day of January 1817. then this Mortgage to be void otherwise the fore-closure of the same to be carried into effect. Given under my hand and seal this 23<sup>d</sup> January 1816.

Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said James Robertson his heirs and assigns forever I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said James Robertson his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and against every Person or Persons whatsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same for any part thereof.
