Know all men by these presents that James Leister of Greenville Distrid in the State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and thirty five dollars to me in hand paid by Spartan Goodlett of the distrid and State aforesaid, have granted bargain'd sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Spartan Goodlett all that plantation tract or parcel of land containing one hundred and twenty eight acres lying and being in the distrid aforesaid on the waters of Richland Creek of Rocky River Beginning on a conditional corner on the branch running thence S. 45 E. 9 chains and fifty links to a black oak thence N. 12 E. 17.50 to a white oak thence N. 88 E. 24 to a black oak thence N. 7 N. 38 chains to a black oak thence N. 85 N. 20 to a conditional corner on the branch thence down the meandering of the branch with the said Spartan Goodlett's land to the beginning — bounded on the South by the S^c Spartan Goodlett's land, on the South and East by William Hedges' land and on the North by Verdoy M. Bee's land, being a lot of land laid out for Henry Hudson as one of the shares of Forest Hudson deceased, and by him conveyed to me on the ninth day of December one thousand Eight hundred and six.
