Know all men by these presents that I Eli Langford of the State of Tennessee Jackson County, in consideration of the sum of thirty dollars to me paid by Josiah Langford of the State of Tennessee Jackson County, Have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Josiah Langford all that plantation or tract of land containing fifty acres more or less situated in the district of Greenville, part of a three hundred and thirty acre tract lying on the waters of Fall creek waters of Saluda river Beginning at a Lock at the conditional line between Stephen and Thomas Morgan running a South West direction across a branch on to the second branch to a Stake thence a North West direction on a conditional line between John Coban and Stephen Morgan to a blaze Spanish oak and forked Chesnut thence along the same course to the original line of said three hundred and thirty three acre tract thence along said original line to a Stake thence to the Beginning. Together with all and singular the Rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have & To Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Josiah Langford his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Josiah Langford his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and assigns and against the claim of every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Know all men by these presents that I Eli Langford of the State of Tennessee Jackson County in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars to me paid by Josiah Langford of Jackson County Tennessee Have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said Josiah Langford all that plantation or tract of land situated in the district of Greenville bounding on the south side of Fall Creek waters of Saluda river butting and bounding on the Rich mountain Beginning at said Fall Creek running S.W. to a Stake thence South East to a Stake near Cane line thence along the steep part of the mountain between Morgan field and Canev thence to Fordy line thence to the Beginning - containing two hundred acres more or less originally granted to John Elledge by patent bearing date the 2^d day of December 1793. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances,
