Know all men by these presents that Sterling Harris for and in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred and fifty dollars to me in hand paid by Thomas Barton both of the State and district aforesaid, Have granted bargained sold & released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Barton a certain tract or parcel of land lying & being in the State and district aforesaid on both sides of the great hole fork of Tyger River Beginning on a large sweet gum near the said Tyger, thence running N. 54 E. 3 ch. to a willow on the bank of a branch thence up the meanders of said branch about 54 ch. to a poplar William Holcomby corner thence N. 42 W. 39 ch. to two chestnuts thence W. 22 ch. to a post oak, thence near Hannah Beloy's fence thence S. 10 W. 17 ch. to a dead red oak, Laban Loftus's corner thence S. 27 W. 9 chains to a chestnut thence S. 41 ch. 50 lks. to a small R. oak thence N. 70 E. 27 ch. to the Beginning supposed to contain one hundred and eighty eight acres, be this same more or less, it being a part of a survey of land granted to John Gowen deceased, and by his last will bequeathed the S. lands to his son Winn B. Gowen and said Winn B. Gowen granted said land to said Sterling Harris and said Harris unto the said Barton Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident to have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto him the said Thomas Barton his heirs or assigns forever and I do hereby warrant and forever defend all and singular the before mentioned premises unto the said Thomas Barton his heirs or assigns against myself my heirs Executors & administrators or any other person whatsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. — As witness my hand and seal this twenty fourth day of July in the year one thousand Eight hundred and sixteen, and fourth year of American Independence.
