of land lying and being in Greenville District on the water of Mountain and
Horse Creek, estimation three hundred and thirty five acres, more or less, ori-
ginally granted to Athel Meeks and by him conveyed to John Barnett, who
conveyed it to the said James Harrison in his lifetime by a Deed dated the
fifteenth day of Jan^y. one thousand seven hundred and ninety nine, which
tract of land the said James Harrison has not heretofore made & executed
a title to the said Isham. & we John H. Harrison, Samuel Earle, Jane Wright
James Harrison Richard Harrison Rowland Thurmond and Early Harris
Heirs and Representatives of the said James Harrison Dec^d. in consideration
of the premises and being willing and anxious that Justice should be done
to the said Isham Harrison, Have granted bargained and sold, and by these
presents do grant bargain and sell to the said Isham Harrison his heirs &
assigns forever. and we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs, executors and
administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises
above mentioned (as will more fully appear on reference to the deed above
named) to the said Isham Harrison his heirs or assigns, from ourselves our heirs
executors or administrators, and all other persons lawfully claiming or to claim the
same or any part thereof. In Witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands
and Seals this twenty fourth day of January in the year of our Lord one thou-
sand eight hundred and fifteen.
