350 South Carolina Greenville District Know all men by these presents that I Hardin Forrest of the State and District aforesaid in consideration of one hundred dollars to me in hand paid by John Lynch the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold & by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said John Lynch his heirs and assigns one certain tract or parcel of land containing by estimation one hundred acres more or less situate in the district aforesaid on the heads of the Branches of Bush Creek waters of Tyger river being part of a tract of land originally granted to James Nichol's Bound as follows: Beginning on James Cox's line at a conditional corner made between S^d Forrest & John Blachwell at the mouth of a small Branch a little above what is called Colhams Cobbin thence with said Cox's line till it intersects said Forest Land and lines whereon he now lives thence with said lines till they intersect R. Lister's lines on a pine corner thence to pursue the lines of lands formerly E. Gorman's but now vines & Gossages from S^d Corner till they intersect the lines of land whereon I have Forest now lives thence with S^d lines till intersects the lines of land now occupied by Joseph Parker thence with said lines to a conditional corner on the ridge above what is called the rock House thence in a direct line from said corner to intersect the rock house and to the source of a small branch below the rock house thence the said branch to be the line to the beginning — Together with all & singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said land & premises belonging or in any wise appertaining to have and to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John Lynch his heirs & assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Ex^{ors} & adm^{rs} to warrant & forever defend all and singular the S^d premises unto the S^d John Lynch his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs or any other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim all or any part thereof.
