 in any manner interested, (Excepting my Lots & Houses
 in the Town of Camden). Together with all & singular
 the rights members, Renditions and appurtenances
 to the same belonging or in any wise incident or apper-
 taining: To have and to hold all and singular the
 premises with the appurtenances, to the said Henry Henson
 Dickinson his heirs and assigns forever. And I the said
 Mary Brown by these presents do bind myself my Heirs
 Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend
 unto the said Henry Henson Dickinson his heirs & assigns
 forever all and singular the premises, and every part &
 parcel thereof, against myself and my heirs and against
 all other persons whomsoever claiming or to claim the
 same or any part thereof, by through, or under me or
 my Heirs - Witness my hand and Seal this fourth day
 of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
 hundred and ten. and in the thirty fourth Year of the
 Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of
