 of land with its appurtenances, and all the estate right, title & interest which
 the said William D. Thomas of right had of in & to the same. To have and to
 hold the S^d piece parcel & tract of land with its appurtenances, unto the said
 Jeremiah Cleveland his heirs and assigns forever, as fully and absolutely as
 I the S^d Thomas Payne might could or ought to grant bargain and sell the sa-
 me, by virtue of a Statute aforesaid, and the said writ of fieri facias or otherwise.
