dollars to me in hand paid by Samuel Steel of the State &
district aforesaid I have granted bargained and sold & by
these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the
said Samuel Steel all that tract or Plantation of Land
Containing three hundred and two acres granted to said
Hugh Dorrough the sixth day of September 1802 granted
by his Excellency John Drayton Esquire, beginning at a
Logwood and running S. 27 W. 61.50 to a gum, thence N. 73
W. 66.75 to a Stake, thence N. 50 E. 78 to a Pine stump
thence S. 40 E. 29 to a white O. thence N. 62 E. 15 to the
beginning. Together with all and singular the rights
members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said
premises and or in any wise incident or appurtenant
to have and to hold all and singular the premises
before mentioned unto the said Samuel Steel heirs
and Executors Administrators and assigns forever against
me and my heirs or Executors or any person or persons
claiming by force under us, or any of us, or from any
other person or persons whatsoever. Witness my hand &
Seal this 23^d day of March one thousand eight hundred &
seven and in the thirty first year of the Independence of
