The State of South Carolina Know all men by these Presents,
that I Richard Lewis of the County of Rutherford and State
of North Carolina for and in consideration of the sum
of thirty one dollars and fifty cents to me in hand paid
by William Holcomb of the district of Greenville & State of South
Carolina have granted bargained sold and released, & by these
presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Wm.
Holcomb a certain tract or parcel of land situate in the district
of Greenville on the waters of South Carolina River beginning on
a poplar on the ancient Indian boundary line running thence
N. 44 chains to a Stake, thence N. 70 W. 15 chs to a Black
Oak on William McClure's line, thence S. 20 East 9 chs 50 links
to a White Oak, thence S. 6 W. 29 chs 50 links to a Lightwood
Stake, John Hickmans corner thence East 6 chs to an Ash
on the old Mill house branch, thence down with the me-
anders of the branch to the beginning, containing forty two
Acres, more or less. being part of a tract of land originally
granted to Ann Saunders by Patent bearing date the
fifteenth day of January 1801. Together with all & singular
the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to
the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or
appertaining; To have and to hold all and singular the
premises before mentioned, unto the said William Holcomb
his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind
myself my heirs Executors Administrators or Assigns
to Warrant and for ever defend all and singular the pre-
mises before mentioned, unto the said William Holcomb his
heirs executor administrators or Assigns against myself my
heirs executor administrators or Assigns, and against all &
singular the claim of every other person or persons whom
soever ⁴⁸ lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part
