 Sink hole fork of Tiger River, beginning on a Post Oak
 Corner North of said tract or parcel of land, and running
 thence East nine chains fifty links, to a White Oak;
 Thence South ten degrees West Sixteen chains, to a
 dead Oak, thence South forty degrees West nine chains,
 to a Burnt, and from thence to the beginning Corner.
 It being the North West Corner of a certain tract of
 land granted to Edmund Bearden and conveyed from
 Bearden to Maj. John Gowen, and from Gowen bequeathed
 to his son Winn B Gowen. Together with all and
 singular the rights members hereditaments & appur-
 tenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise
 Incident or appertaining: To have and to hold all &
 singular the premises before mentioned, unto the
 said Joseph and William Barton their heirs & assigns
 forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs
