assigns to warrant and defend the said land for ever to the  
s<sup>r</sup> Johnston Bain his heirs and assigns against all rights  
claims or demands whereby the said premises may or might  
be encumbered contrary to the true use & meaning of these  
presents, in witness whereof the said James Franks hath  
set his hand and Seal, this day and year above written.

Street corner of lot No 3 & runs south 16 West along the main Street one  
hundred feet to a Stake corner of lot No 5 thence north 74 West one hun-  
red & twenty six feet & one fourth part to a Stake corner of back lot & 14 there  
to 16 East one hundred feet to a Stake three South 74 East one hundred  
seventy six feet to the beginning Together with all and singular the  
rights, members & appurtenances therunto belonging or in anywise  
appertaining to have and to hold all & singular the premises before
