bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant  
and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the  
said Mr Dunklin his heirs and assigns against myself & my heirs  
and against Every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully  
claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my  
hand and Seal this fifteenth day of January in the year of our  
Lord one thousand eight hundred & Eighteen & In the forty seven  
Year of the Independence of the United States of America

This Indenture made this twenty fifth of November 1809 between Jonas  
Dawson & Abner Senter of Greenville district of the State of S<sup>C</sup>  
Carolina of the one part & the aforesaid Dawson of S<sup>C</sup> Carolina  
Barnwell county of the other part witnesseth that for & in con-  
sideration of the sum of five hundred dollars to the aforesaid  
Dawson in hand paid before the making & delivery of this  
present the receipt whereof is acknowledged in every par-  
& parcel thereof given granted bargained and sold unto  
Abner Senter a certain piece or parcel of land containing  
five hundred acres be the same more or less lying & being on  
the Middle fork of Tyger river beginning on a red oak thence  
N 88 E 15 chains to a maple thence S 80 E 23 chains 40 links to a Sta-  
thence along by the line to Kansas line thence along S. line until it inter-  
sects the line again to a Spanish oak to a Saplin being made a co-  
ditional corner between George Ham & Jonas Dawson thence down the  
Middle branch to a white oak Saplin at the mouth of S<sup>C</sup> branch  
from thence to a large white oak Abner Senter corner thence S 20 W 75
