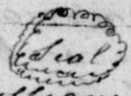

& District aforesaid for the sum of two hundred and
fifty dollars to me in hand paid by John & Charles
Bulow of Charleston and state aforesaid do sell & convey all
my right interest or claim to the one half of a tract of land
situate in Greenville District known by the name of the White
plains - unto the said John & Charles Bulow and their heirs or
assigns for ever, To have to hold all and singular the rights
& premises as aforesaid and I do by these presents warrant
and defend the one half of said tract of Land unto the said
John & Charles their heirs & assigns against any person lawfully
claiming the same In testimony whereof I have hereunto affixed
my hand & seal this 14th of Sept^r 1817
