E. 50 - 21 Chains to the beginning Supposed to be fifty acres of Land be the same more or less to have & to hold all & singular the premises before Mentioned unto the said Hewlet Sullivan forever Together with the Rights Members Hereditaments & Appurtenances to them belonging or in anywise incident or Appurtenancing & I hereby bind myself my heirs Executors &c. to warrant & forever Defend the said premises to the said Sullivan his Heirs & Assigns against our selves & our Heirs or assigns & against Every person or persons Whomsoever Claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof in witness Whereof we have hereunto set our hands & seals this month day of November 1816 Signed Sealed & Delivered in presence of

State of South Carolina Greenville District Know all men by these presents that we Beville Bowen & Elijah Bennett both of the state of Kentucky & Livingston County for & in consideration of the sum of two hundred & fifty Dollars to us in hand paid by Hewlet Sullivan of the State of South Carolina & Greenville District have Granted bargained & sold & by these presents do Grant Bargain sell & Release unto the said Hewlet Sullivan a parcel or Tract of Land containing Eighty Eight Acres be the same more or less situated in Greenville District adjoining said Sullivan on the East & South West Beginning on a Maple on a branch & running West 15 - 80 to a post Oak & Thence running S. 15 E. - 24 to a white Oak 3x on Nuddy River adjoining Hudson Berrys land Thence Down said River to the mouth of the first branch to a Maple 3x Thence up the said branch to the beginning Maple corner adjoining said Sullivan Together with all & singular the rights Members Hereditaments & Appurtenances unto the said premises belonging or in anywise belonging or incident or Appurtenancing to have & to hold all & singular the premises before Mentioned unto the said Hewlet Sullivan his Heirs & Assigns forever & we do hereby bind our selves our heirs & assigns to warrant & forever Defend
