 Plat to the Original Grant annexed Reference being there
 unto had well more fully appear together with all and
 singular the Rights Members Hereditaments and appur
 - tenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise
 incident or Appertaining to have and to hold all and
 singular the premises before mentioned unto the said
 John Hammitt his heirs and Assigns forever I do hereby
 bind myself & my heirs Executors & Administrators to
 warrant & forever defend all & singular the premises
 before mentioned unto the said John Hammitt his heirs
 & Assigns against myself and my heirs Lawfully claim
 - ing the same or any part thereof & with this it is agreed
 that no part of the Purchase money now Received is ever
 to be returned on Account of any Older Survey or other
 claim What ever Building into said land and taking any
 part or even the whole thereof that being at the sole
 Request of the purchaser, Thomas Woodworth conveyed his
 half of the above mentioned Tract of Land to Wm Turpin
 by Deed bearing date 2^d day of May 1797 in Witness
 Whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my
 Seal in Charleston this 12th day of March in the Year of
 Our Lord one Thousand Eight hundred & Eighteen
 Witnesses
