 his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby <sup>bind</sup> myself my heirs  
 executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend  
 all and singular the s<sup>d</sup> premises unto the s<sup>d</sup> Geo. W. Carl his heirs  
 & assigns against myself my heirs and against all & every other  
 person or persons whomsoever Lawfully claiming or to claim  
 the same or any part thereof. In witness whereof I have here  
 unto set my hand and seal this eighth day of October in the  
 Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & Eighteen signed
