men by these Presents that I George Grace of the State & district aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars to me in hand paid by John Holland of the State and district aforesaid hath bargained and sold unto the said John Holland a certain tract or parcel of land containing thirty two acres more or less situate in the district aforesaid lying & being on the south side of mountain creek waters of saluda river beginning at a white oak X at or near the creek adjoining lands of the said John Holland running thence S. 60 E. 43. 50 to a white oak + on South adjoining lands of Peter French thence up the meanders of S. mountain Creek adjoining lands of Joseph Smith to the beginning. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, & appurtenances, to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John Holland his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby <sup>bind</sup> my self my heirs Exec<sup>rs</sup> & assigns to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said John Holland his heirs & assigns and against every other person lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof. As Witness my hand and seal this 15<sup>th</sup> day of June one thousand eight hundred and eighteen. Signed sealed & delivered in the presence of Just Edmund Hodges, John Wright, — George Grace
