Bartlett Whorton a tract or parcel of land lying and being in the district aforesaid on both sides of Mill creek a branch of S^c. Pacolati. Beginning at a light wood stake John Sloan, corner & running thence N^o 17^o 11' 24" Ch^o: 75 & 1/2 to a post oak thence S 55^o 11' 40" Ch^o: to a black oak thence S 18^o E 24 ch^o: 75 to a stake near a pine Sloan, corner thence with his line N 55 East to the beginning containing by Estimation Ninety Nine acres to the same more or less the same being part of a survey of land made for & granted to W^m. Jamison by patent bearing date April 5th 1790 & by him conveyed to John Gowen & by him a part of the same to me together with all & singular the rights, members, hereditaments, & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Bartlett Whorton his heirs & assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & Admors to warrant & forever defend all & singular the s^d premises unto the s^d. Bartlett Whorton his heirs & assigns against me & my heirs & against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
