and do bear for and towards my daughter Hannah Russell
wife of Richard Russell of the said district; and for the further
consideration of one dollar to me paid by the said Hannah
Russell. Have given, granted, bargained and delivered and by
these presents do give, grant, bargain and deliver, unto the said
Hannah Russell and to the heirs of her body a certain Negro
child named Mary about six years old. To have and to hold the
said Negro girl Mary with her future increase unto the said
Hannah Russell and the heirs of her body hereafter forever, to
be divided by sale or otherwise at the death of her present husband
and Richard Russell equally between her and her said heirs
and in case she should die first then to be divided as aforesaid
among her said heirs. Herby warranting and defending the
said Negro Slave and her future increase unto the said Hannah
Russell and her heirs as aforesaid. Witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and affixed my seal this 29th day of March 1817
