344 South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I Daniel Pike of Greenville district & State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred forty dollars to me in hand paid by Samuel Hamby of the district & State aforesaid have granted bargained sold & released by these presents do grant bargain sell unto the said Samuel Hamby a plantation or tract of land lying & being situate in the district & State aforesaid on banks of Goldens creek waters of Enore River & being a part of a tract of land originally granted to James Wafford & conveyed to the said Pike the land to be conveyed beginning at Po 34 Run N. 70 W. 20 to Po 34 then N 60 to Po 34 N 72 E. 15 to Po 34 S 70 E. 30 to a chestnut & hickory 34 each S 3 50 to Po 34 S 50 W. 26 to Stake 34 S 75 E. 10 to head then with said road to the beginning including two hundred acres to the same more or less together with all singular the right members, hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to have & to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Samuel Hamby & I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & adm<sup>rs</sup> to warrant & forever defende all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Samuel Hamby his heirs & assigns forever against myself & my heirs & against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof In witness whereof I have unto set my hand & seal this first day of February 1819 signed & delivered in presence of
