 hereby bind myself my heirs, executor, and administrators to warrant  
 and forever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said  
 Rolly Jenkins his heirs and assigns against myself & my heirs  
 and against every other person, whomsoever lawfully claiming  
 or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand

 Benjamin Dunham a certain Lot of land Situate lying &  
 being in the Village of Greenville Court house aforesaid  
 known and distinguished in the additional plan  
 of the said Village as laid out by said M<sup>re</sup> Bee by  
 the number thirteen (N<sup>o</sup> 13) in the South East square  
 of the said Village, Containing one hundred feet
