


State of South Carolina. Know all men by these Presents that I James S. Fisher of Spartanburg district & State aforesaid, for & in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to me paid by William Christopher of Buncombe County North Carolina, HAVE granted bargained sold and released and by these Presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said William Christopher a certain tract or parcel of land situate in the district of Greenville on both sides of Mill Creek waters of South Piedmont River beginning at a Red Oak running thence N. 17 W. 12 ch, 50 links to a Stake thence S. 55 W. 40 ch to a Stake thence S. 18 E. 72 ch 50 links to a Stake thence to the beginning, containing by estimation fifty acres more or less. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining: To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said William Christopher his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William Christopher his heirs and assigns, against myself my heirs executors administrators or assigns, and against all and singular the claims of every other person or persons whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof; In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this fourteenth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighteen.

Personally came William Holcombe before me the subscribing Justice, and made oath that he saw James Fisher sign seal and deliver the within deed of conveyance to William Christopher for the use and purpose in it mentioned; and that William Turner was a subscribing Witness with himself to the same.
