 tion of the sum of one hundred  
 dollars in hand paid to me by  
 David Barnett of the "district"

aforesaid have bargained sold and released unto D. Barnett a certain tract or  
 parcel of land lying and being in the district aforesaid, on some branch, the  
 waters of Morgan's Creek, Beginning on a Red Oak bush a corner between William  
 Butler and myself, running thence East 37 ch to a Chestnut a corner of the land which  
 the sd. William Johnson lies, thence S 55 E. 6 ch. 50 to a P. Oak old corner thence N 21 W.  
 34 ch. 25 chs to a Port Oak near a dead P. Oak Goodgion's Corner, thence N 55 W. 5 ch. 40 chs  
 to a Chestnut, a corner between W. Butler & myself - thence S 55 W 23 chs. to a Red Oak by a  
 Road, thence S 24 W. 20 chs to the beginning, supposed to contain eighty four acres, be  
 the same more or less, it being part of a Survey of land originally granted to Robt.  
 Goodgion. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments & appur-  
 tenances to the sd. Premises belonging in any wise incident - To have and to hold  
 all and singular the rights and appurtenances unto the said David Barnett his heirs Exors  
 or Administrators forever. And I do hereby warrant and forever defend the same or any  
 part thereof, from myself my heirs executors or Administrators, or from any other person  
 whomsoever, lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof - Witness my hand & seal  
 this the 7<sup>th</sup> day of Sept<sup>r</sup> in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and  
 eighteen, and in the forty first year of American Independence.

 five pounds Sterling to me in hand paid by Samuel Howard of Sumville County  
 South Carolina have granted bargained sold and released & by these presents do  
 grant bargain sell & release unto Samuel Howard of Sumville County & State afo-  
 said all that plantation or tract of land containing one hundred acres  
 situate lying and being in Greenville County & State aforesaid on Durbin's Creek bound-  
 ed on east by the old Indian boundary & on the other three square by Sacast  
 land at the time it was surveyed granted to the aforesaid James McLaughlin  
 the 3<sup>d</sup> of April 1786 and in the tenth year of the Independence of the United  
 States of America recorded in grant book 3333 page 18. Together with  
 all and singular the rights members hereditaments and
